We would like to invite your club to take part in the International Budo Council National Championships 2014.

Date: Sunday, 29 June 2014

Venue: High Wycombe Judo Centre, Barry Close, High Wycombe, Bucks

In order to get the championships off to a reasonable start we will not accept entries from any contestant under 30 kilos after 9.30am prompt, however far they have travelled, and however good their reason. This is in fairness to all those arriving promptly.

Please note that the Juniors (under 30kg) will weigh in first with the contests starting at approx. 09.45am, followed by the remaining categories, each category will be fought through **to the finals**. Medals will then be awarded at the end of each category in order that children will be able to return to their homes at a reasonable time. The Intermediates will commence at approx. 12.30pm, and finally the Seniors at approx. 3pm.

As far as possible students will be grouped against students from other clubs in small groups to fight off in a pool system. If there are less than 5 competitors in a category, we will use the recharge system, to ensure that all competitors get a reasonable number of contest. In the event that we have a very large category (usually boys), this will be separated into higher and lower grades and fought as two separate categories. The junior opens and intermediates will compete using the recharge system.

The championships will be contested under the IBC contest rules, contestants **MUST** wear the highest grade they hold, whether this is an IBC grade or not. Any competitors found to be wearing the wrong grade will be disqualified from the competition, there will be no refund of entry fee.

IBC TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament will be contested under the IBC Contest Rules
2. The points awarded will be as follows; Ippon - 10 Points, Waza Ari - 7 points, Yusei Gachi - 1 point.
3. All persons present during the competition **MUST** strictly observe silence during contests.
4. Spectators **MUST NOT** go into the contest areas, or down the side of the mats without permission.
5. The decision of the Referee is **FINAL**.
6. Coaching will **NOT** be allowed. Any contestant, receiving coaching during their contest will be disqualified from the tournament.
7. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate categories if there is an insufficient entry for any category. The right is also reserved to change categories if the need so arises.
8. Any complaint must be made in writing to the Chief Referee or Official.
9. All officers of the IBC organise events for the benefit of the students, and give up their time freely. Any person physically or verbally abusing event officials will be asked to leave, and barred from all future IBC events.
10. Registration and Weighing-in times must be strictly adhered to any contestant arriving after the stated time will be refused entry.
11. Weight = body weight plus gi bottoms.
12. All competitors must wear a clean, correctly fitted **white** suit.
13. **Current proof** of membership **must** be **produced** on entry, please ensure that it has an up to date photograph.
14. Neither the IBC, its servants, agents or employees are under any liability whatsoever in respect of personal injury, loss or damage, howsoever arising whilst people are in attendance at this event.
15. Every Competitor **MUST** be free from sickness and injury on the day of the event. Chronic conditions and injury (e.g. epilepsy, diabetes, asthma etc.) **MUST** be reported to the Chief Official prior to competing.
16. The IBC does not condone the starving/dehydrating of competitors to "make" the weight. This is a dangerous practice, which can lead to serious injury, and will be considered as cheating. In the case of children this will be considered a safeguarding issue, and will be referred to the IBC child protection officer.

Please Note: Armlocks, Chokes and Strangles will be permitted in categories over 40kg, however none of these techniques will be permitted when fighting white or yellow belts.

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
